

Pinterest Lite: A 10■Minute Pin Workflow (For Non■Designers)

Reuse one Canva template. Ship daily pins. Send steady traffic to your blog with minimal effort.

■ Step 1	Create a single Canva template (1000×1500). Large title, subtle background, your URL.
■ Step 2	Duplicate template 5× and swap only the title text.
■ Step 3	Export all pins at once (PNG).
■ Step 4	Write 1–2■sentence description with 3–5 natural keywords.
■ Step 5	Link each pin directly to its matching post and add the same image near the top of the pos
■ Step 6	Publish one pin per weekday (queue if you like).
